**CERTIFICATION OF NO OBJECTION TO THE FIRST MONTHLY FEE

1. I am attorney-at-law of the State of New Jersey and a principal of Porzio, Bromberg & Newman, PC ("Porzio"), counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors ("The Committee").

2. I submit this Certification pursuant to the Administrative Fee Order dated September 26, 2007 Establishing Procedures for Allowance and Payment of Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses to Professionals (ECF Doc. #33) (the "Administrative Order").

3. Pursuant to the Administrative Order, each Notice Party shall have twenty (20) days after service of a Monthly Fee Statement to object. Upon the expiration of the Objection Deadline, each Professional may file a certification of no objection after which the Debtor is

authorized to pay each Professional an amount equal to the lesser of: (i) eighty percent (80%) of the fees and one hundred percent (100%) of the expenses requested in the Monthly Fee Statement.

4. On December 20, 2007, Porzio filed its First Monthly Fee Statement (ECF Doc. 272). Pursuant to the Administrative Order, the Objection Deadline was **January 9, 2008**.

5. A review of the ECF Docket indicates that no objections have been filed to the First Monthly Fee Statement. In addition, Porzio received no objections to the First Monthly Fee Statement.

6. Accordingly, the Debtor has been instructed to pay Porzio the sums set forth in the First Monthly Fee Statement.
